**Emergency Pack:** Each child will be asked to bring a one-gallon zip-lock bag filled with food and drinks to be placed in the child's classroom. Items that are recommended are:

- 2-Bottles of water or juice boxes
- 4-Granola bars or nutrition bars
- 2-Cheese crackers
- 1-Small game
- Letter or note from parents

Unused food will be eaten at the end of the year or sent home. Check the shelf life of the items you place in the pack to make sure they will survive nine months. Fill the bag with as much food as you can. Write the date, your child's name, and teacher's name on the pack outside of the pack. (If you are able to donate one or two cans of food that will be placed in our sea container we welcome donations for our school-wide emergency plan.)
