 - Double space, minimum one side, not to exceed two sides. Typed or handwritten
 - Paper-lined or computer; 8 1/2 x 11
 - <u>MUST HAVE</u>: On BACK (right top corner), FIRST AND LAST NAME, Grade, Age, and Teachers Name and **School**

2. SECOND, THIRD AND FOURTH GRADE POSTER CONTEST

- THEME: "I HAVE THE POWER TO BE DRUG FREE"
- Construction paper or poster board (any color) no larger than 22 x 28
- Materials can include: Crayons, Markers, Water color, Color Pencils, Natural Products
